Background Carbonic anhydrase III (CAIII) is a member of a multigene family (at least

six separate genes are known) that encodes carbonic anhydrase

isozymes. These carbonic anhydrases are a class of metalloenzymes that

catalyze the reversible hydration of carbon dioxide. They are

differentially expressed in a number of cell types. The expression of the CA3 gene is strictly tissue specific and present at high levels in skeletal

muscle and much lower levels in cardiac and smooth muscle.

Immunogen Polyclonal antibody is produced by immunizing animals with a synthetic

peptide of CA III.

Purification Polyclonal antibody was purified by immunogen affinity chromatography.


