General Information

Background	SOX SRY-related HMG-box family of transcription factors involved in the regulation of embryonic development and in the determination of the cell fate. The encoded protein may act as a transcriptional activator after forming a protein complex with other proteins. This protein may be involved in brain development and function. This protein is also highly expressed in the majority of human hepatocellular carcinomas and promotes cellular proliferation and enhanced tumor growth.
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Immunogen	Polyclonal antibody is produced by immunizing animals with a synthetic peptide of P-SOX8 (S327).
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Purification	Polyclonal antibody was purified by Protein A affinity chromatography.
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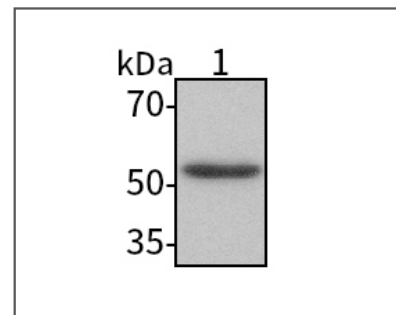
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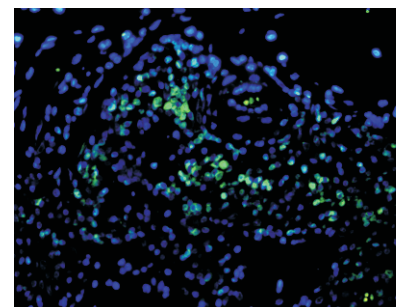

Western blot-Anti-P-SOX8 (S327) pAb

Lane 1: Human SHY5Y cell lysate 24μg
 Separation gel: 10% polyacrylamide
 Electrophoresis: 100V, 4°C, 3h
 Transmembrane: 100V, 4°C, 1h
 Blocking: 5% w/v nonfat dry milk, 1 × TBST, at RT with gentle shaking
 Primary antibody: 1:1000 in blocking buffer, 4°C, overnight
 Visualization: ECL

Sample: Human colon cancer tissue
 Primary antibody: 1:200, 4°C, overnight
 Secondary antibody-CY3: 1:200, at room temperature, 1h
