General Information

Background	Somatostatin, also known as growth hormone-inhibiting hormone (GHIH) or by several other names, is a peptide hormone that regulates the endocrine system and affects neurotransmission and cell proliferation via interaction with G protein-coupled somatostatin receptors and inhibition of the release of numerous secondary hormones. Somatostatin is found in both the hypothalamus and pancreas. Somatostatin is thought to be involved in the regulation of Insulin synthesis. y. Somatostatin affects rates of neurotransmission in the central nervous system and proliferation of both normal and tumorigenic cells.
Immunogen	Polyclonal antibody is produced by immunizing animals with a synthetic peptide of Somatostatin.
Purification	Polyclonal antibody was purified by Protein A affinity chromatography.

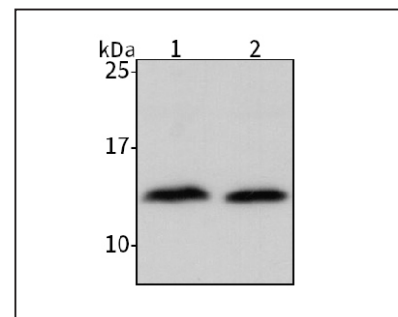

Lane 1: Mouse colon tissue lysate

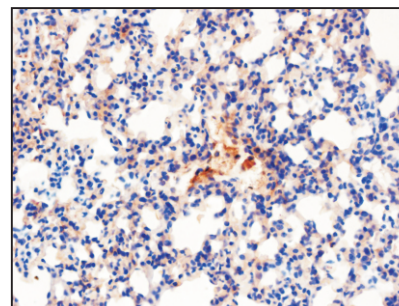
Lane 2: Rat colon tissue lysate

Lysates/proteins at 20-50 µg per lane.

Sample: Mouse lung (LPS treated) tissue

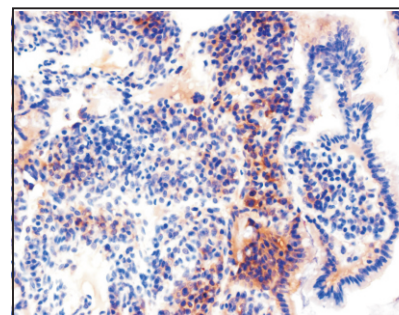
Antigen retrieval: pH 9.0 Tris-EDTA buffer

Primary antibody: 1:200, 4°C, overnight

Secondary antibody-Biotin: 1:150, 37°C, 1h

Streptavidin-HRP: 1:200, 37°C, 30min

Color Developing: DAB



Immunohistochemistry-Anti-Somatostatin pAb

Sample: Rat colon (LPS treated) tissue

Antigen retrieval: pH 9.0 Tris-EDTA buffer

Primary antibody: 1:200, 4°C, overnight

Secondary antibody-Biotin: 1:150, 37°C, 1h

Streptavidin-HRP: 1:200, 37°C, 30min

Color Developing: DAB
