General Information

Background	The myc tag is a short synthetic peptide sequence derived from the myc protein, which can be used to the N-terminus or C-terminus of any protein without affecting its function, for isolation and study when antibodies cannot be obtained.
Immunogen	Polyclonal antibody is produced by immunizing animals with a synthetic peptide of Myc tag.
Purification	Polyclonal antibody was purified by immunogen affinity chromatography.

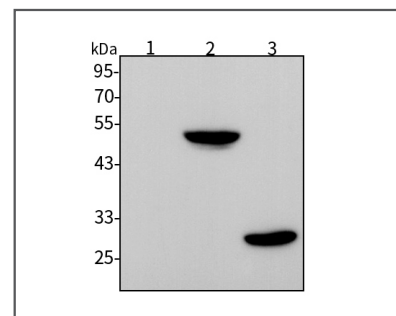
